

Sub: Extension of benefit of Grade Pay of Rs. 4200 (Non-functional) to staff working in the cadre of Pharmacist in case of transfer on own request

Pharmacists who join in the entry grade of GP Rs.2800/- (presently Level 5) are eligible for non-functional upgradation to GP Rs.4200/- (presently Level 6) after 2 years of regular service in the Grade, in terms of RBE No.47/2010 dated 30.3.2010 as further clarified vide RBE. No. 165/2010 dated 19.11.2010.

2. In the case of a Pharmacist who opts for own request transfer to a different Railway/ seniority units on bottom seniority, a query has been raised by North Western Railway as to whether the benefit of counting service in the old seniority unit will apply for the grant of Non-functional Upgradation to GP Rs. 4200/- (Level 6) for the said Pharmacists, in the new seniority unit.

3. It is pointed out that the specific issue raised in para 2 above is already covered by circular No.E(NG)I-2006/PN1/5 dated 21.3.2006 (circulated as RBE. No.34/2006) and may be dealt in accordance with the terms of the said circular.
